

Eskimo Escapades benefits the Patricia Neal Innovative Recreation Cooperative (IRC), the Dream Connection and the Adventure Amputee Camp.

The Patricia Neal Rehabilitation Center is the largest rehabilitation facility in the state and surrounding areas and provides treatment to individuals who have suffered injuries resulting in physical or mental disabilities. Once patients regain the ability to function in their outside lives, they have the opportunity to participate in an array of community activities designed for continued learning and recreation. Patricia Neal Innovative Recreation Cooperative (IRC) is geared towards development and fun. Activities such as horse back riding, snow skiing, water skiing, wake boarding, alpine tower climbing, and golf are all part of the Patricia Neal IRC repertoire. These activities require specialized equipment for the participants and are made possible by your donations and volunteers.

The Dream Connection is a not-for-profit organization, which benefits regional children who hold a dream and are diagnosed with a life-threatening illness. The Dream Connection selects its children based upon a number of criteria. Each dream fulfilled is unique and powerful as it allows a child the resources and abilities to have his or her dream brought to life, and every donation you make will go towards helping one more child realize his or her dream within their lifetime.

For the last five years, Eskimo Escapades has provided volunteers and a big picnic for the July Adventure Amputee Camp (AAC) water ski day in Fontana, North Carolina. The AAC is staffed by an all volunteer organization and over 30 amputee kids from across the United States participate in a five day camp for a very nominal fee (\$25) although the cost per child is approximately \$600.
